# 22nd NORDIC CONGRESS OF GENERAL PRACTICE

The 22nd Nordic Congress of General Practice will take place in Stavanger, Norway from 21.-23. of June 2022. It is preceded by a preconference for GP trainees on the 20th of June.

The conference will have a special focus on future possibilities and challenges in general practice. The Nordic Congress is an important meeting place for clinicians, researchers and administrators, young and experienced, with a shared interest in primary care.

The Nordic Congress represents a unique opportunity for discussions and exchange of ideas and research, and for promoting general practice perspectives. Over 350 abstracts have been submitted.

## BURSARIES

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- 1.A confirmation/declaration of the applicant being a GP trainee or up to 5 years after finishing training.
- 2.A description of any social reason/inequities (ie being a single parent, having disabilities, being the only person in a household who receives income)
- 3.A plan for how to share gained experience (How do you plan to invest the results of this experience in your country? How will you benefit from attending the event?)
- 4.Short summary of a personal profile, including volunteer activity and impressions on family medicine (engagement in the field)
